Ingredients

250g plain flour
125g butter, chilled and
diced, plus extra for the tin
1 medium egg
100g jam

STEP 1

Put the flour, butter and a pinch of salt in a bowl and rub them together with your fingertips. When the mixture looks and feels like fresh breadcrumbs, stir in the egg. Add 1 tbsp cold water, then start to bring the dough together in one lump with your hands - try not to knead it too much! Add 1 more tbsp of water if it's not coming together, but try not to add more than that. Wrap in cling film and chill in the fridge for 30 mins.

STEP 2

Heat oven to 200C/180C fan/gas 6. Butter your tart tin, then dust your work surface with flour. Unwrap and roll out the chilled pastry so it's about the thickness of a £1 coin, then use a round cutter to cut out 12 circles, big enough to line the holes in the tin. Dollop 1-2 tsp of your chosen filling into each one and pop them on top.

STEP 3


Bake for 15-18 mins or until golden and the filling is starting to bubble a little. Leave to cool in the tin for a few mins then carefully transfer to a wire rack to cool completely.




