## WHAT TO DO IF YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS

If you have any symptoms of COVID-19 (a temperature, a new continuous cough, a loss of taste or smell) please do not attend the session. You can join us on zoom! If you, or someone you have had close contact with, have had a positive COVID-19 test result in the last 14 days, please do not attend the session and follow government guidelines on self-isolating

## TRAVELLING TO SESSION

If you are travelling to the session by bus, train, or taxi, remember to follow government guidelines and face coverings must be worn



## WHAT TO DO ON ARRIVAL

When you arrive, make your way to the check in point outside the theatre entrance. If there is a queue, please wait on the floor markers.

We will check you in for NHS Track and Trace.

We will then direct you to either the garden space or the theatre space ready for the session to start!

Parents are not able to stay to on site during the session.


## FACE COVERINGS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING

You need to wear a face covering (unless you are exempt) in all indoor spaces  
Please keep social distancing both inside and outside!



## TOILETS

We have blocked off some toilets for social distancing (Ladies: max. 3 people in, Mens: 1 at a time). The unisex/accessible toilet is available to use. Please queue on the floor markers and keep to the one way system marked on the floor.



## HYGIENE

Make sure you wash your hands regularly (Sing 'Happy Birthday' twice!)

Use the hand sanitising stations throughout the building

Make sure you cough into arm and catch sneezes in a tissue, then use bins provided and wash your hands

We will be cleaning all public areas and toilets more regularly




## WHAT TO EXPECT IN THE SESSION

The sessions will be held outside or in the theatre space (weather dependant). Our existing air handling system in the theatre is designed to provide fresh air with no recirculation
